Let kick off with this great news, On March 3, 2024, we achieved a significant milestone by being officially registered under the Nigeria Corporate Affairs Commission with registration number 7428372. This registration empowers us to proceed with obtaining the Certificate for Special Control Unit against Money Laundering and a Tax Identification Number.

Since April 2023, Ifeoluwa has been on a transformative path at Kanthari, which has led to a successful graduation with 21 other social change makers from 11 countries, Ifeoluwa's dedication has not only marked an end but a new beginning in her mission to create positive impacts in the lives of children and youth with Albinism in Nigeria.

Exposure trips

One of our core values is bringing joy and smiles to our beneficiaries' faces, enhancing their knowledge and visibility. Recently, we organized exposure trips for six children, including those with/without Albinism, to the largest mall in Ibadan. This experience was meaningful as it was their first time visiting, allowing them to learn and have fun in a new environment.

Celebrating the future

In celebration of Menstrual Hygiene Day, World Boy Child Day, and Children's Day, we had the privilege to collaborate with Bramble Network to reinforce our mutual dedication to uplifting underserved communities. Together, we empowered young minds with crucial menstrual hygiene education and highlighted the significance of boys' well-being, and in all we celebrate the simple joys of childhood. Together we brought essential knowledge, happinesses, and laughter to rural children and children with albinism.

Umbrella units

To prevent sunburn and skin cancer among children with Albinism, we have launched umbrella units where sun protection materials are provided free of charge to children with Albinism, and offered to others at 50% of the cost price.

We keep learning

Ifeoluwa pursued capacity-building in Human Rights and Advocacy through a program organized by the Women's Health and Equal Rights Initiative enhancing her understanding of leadership, financial literacy, budgeting, entrepreneurship, and life-coping skills.. She also pitched and got financial support for umbrella units,

Our challenges

Five of our beneficiaries, are out of school, while those in school lack essential school materials such as books, clothes, school bags, and food. This situation isolates them and hinders their academic performance.

Additionally, we have not secured suitable office space, which limits our visibility, hampers program coordination, and prevents our beneficiaries from visiting us for one-on-one mentorship.

Your support can help us overcome these obstacles by enabling children with Albinism to return to school and by establishing a community meeting center.
