

This past quarter, we took a bold step forward in our School Outreach Campaign Against Bullying, using students with albinism as a case study to drive home the message of respect, inclusion, and equal rights.

Journey So Far

Through interactive sessions, storytelling.., and engaging discussions, we visited ten schools and reached overr 1,000 students. Our approach was simple yet impactfulhelp students understand albinism, break myths, and encourage empathy.

Impact so far

Ayoade's Story: From Fear to Confiden

Ayoade, a young student, was afraid to go to school because his classmates bullied him. He often stayed home, and when he did go, he avoided everyone and found it hard to join class activities. But after we visited his school to raise awareness, things changed. His teachers now understand his struggles, and his classmates have learned to treat him with kindness and respect. Today, Ayoade enjoys school, plays with his friends, and does well in his studies.



Azeez's Family: Learning to Belong

The Azeez family has four children with albinism. They used to stay away from social events because they were afraid of being treated badly. They lacked confidence and felt like they didn't belong. But after attending our workshop, they saw things differently. They gained the courage to step out, join Iretiola community activities, and connect with others. Today, they are active in their community, showing that self-acceptance and inclusion can remove barriers.
