Strengthening Our Team

We continue to invest in our people by providing training for our staff and volunteers. These sessions help strengthen our knowledge, leadership, teamwork, and advocacy skills, ensuring that we serve our communities with professionalism and greater impact.

Advocacy Visits to Stakeholders

We carried out advocacy visits to the Oyo State Ministry of Health, hospitals, and other key stakeholders. These meetings focused on introducing our project, discussing the rights and health needs of persons with albinism, and securing support for more inclusive healthcare services.

Health Workers Awareness Workshop

We organized a disability rights and albinism awareness workshop for health workers, especially midwives, in Ibadan. The training addressed common myths and misconceptions about albinism while promoting respectful, inclusive, and rights-based healthcare for every child and family.

Community Dialogue for Inclusion

To reduce stigma and discrimination, we organized a community dialogue bringing together community leaders, religious leaders, educators, parents, and community members. Participants discussed the facts about albinism, challenged harmful beliefs, and explored practical ways to build more inclusive communities.
